Re: SNOW DAYS

As winter weather approaches, this is a reminder of how BASCOL operates for all registered BASCOL children when normal school hours are altered due to weather or other conditions. The following highlights are BASCOL's procedures during these special days when the weather is too severe for school to continue, but great for an exciting special day at BASCOL.

<u>Please Note: Additional Fees for Extended Child Care hours may apply. Please see</u> page 11 of your BASCOL Parent Handbook.

IF there is a delay in the time school opens:

THEN:

- BASCOL opens at 6:30am and remains open with activities and programming until the time the school day begins.
- <u>BASCOL can only guarantee room for a child who is regularly</u> <u>scheduled for that morning.</u> <u>If your child does not attend all</u> <u>mornings, attends after school only or is SHO PLUS, we cannot</u> <u>guarantee room for your child on a school delay</u>. You will need to call the BASCOL Office at 7:30 am to see if we have space to add your child to our program. If you show up at the site without calling the BASCOL Office first, your child may not be able to stay due to maintaining staff to child ratio.
- PLEASE NOTE: If Liverpool goes from a delay to a closing all children in attendance that morning will be bussed to their Full Day Site (see list for which Full Day you go to):
 - CHE, DDE, LBE, and LE goes to Long Branch Elementary, 4035 Long Branch Road
 EE, MRE, SRE and WFE goes to Morgan Road Elementary,
 - 4340 Wetzel Road

IF The district decides that school will not open due to snow or other conditions prior to the start of school:

THEN: BASCOL is open to all registered BASCOL children from 6:30 am until 6:00 pm at your Full Day site.

- Please pack a lunch, including a beverage for your child.
- BASCOL will serve a morning breakfast and afternoon snack as usual.
- Please pack outdoor clothing for your child. The temperature outside dictates how long we play outside, but we usually go outside, even if for just a few minutes, to play in the snow. Hats, gloves or mittens, snowsuit, boots, extra socks and pants are needed to ensure your child is warm and dressed appropriately for outdoor play. Please be sure to pack these for your child every time there is a snow day **and daily at BASCOL during snowy months.**

IF the school district calls for early dismissal once school has begun:

THEN: a. When school is dismissed **BEFORE 12 NOON**:

- If your child is scheduled to attend BASCOL after school, he/she will be bussed to his/her full day site by Liverpool District Buses to LBE or MRE. The BASCOL staff will be at the school prior to dismissal to gather the BASCOL children, take attendance and escort them to the correct bus for transport. BASCOL staff will also be at the full day site when the bus arrives to escort the children off the bus, take attendance once again, and be with your child as the snow day fun begins!
- b. When school is dismissed AFTER 12 NOON:
 - BASCOL begins immediately upon the early school dismissal **at your child's home school.** Children go directly to the BASCOL room as usual when school is dismissed.
 - <u>BASCOL can only guarantee room for a child who is regularly</u> <u>scheduled for that afternoon.</u> <u>If your child does not attend all</u> <u>afternoons, attends before school only or is SHO PLUS, we</u> <u>cannot guarantee room for your child on an early dismissal</u>.

BASCOL is open at 6:30 am until 6:00 pm whenever school is closed or normal school hours are altered. <u>However, in case of an extreme emergency, if BASCOL were to delay or</u> <u>close, it would be announced on local television and radio stations, as follows;</u>

TV stations = WSTM-TV3, WTVH-TV5, & 9WSYR. Radio stations = Y94, WHEN, 107.9, B104.7 and WSYR.
