A Safe Environment

Child care program, started by working parents, grew from 1 to 13 sites

Two decades ago, concerned working parents had the idea to create a licensed, quality childcare program for school-age children for before and after school hours.

That is how Before and After School Child Care on Location Inc., known as BAS-COL, got its start.

Now, as it celebrates its 20th anniversary, the program is still going strong. Since it began, it has expanded from its original site in Liverpool to 13 sites in five school districts in Onondaga County.

"We opened our first site in September of 1992, and two additional locations were opened that December — that's how quickly it took off," said Candace B. Edwards, executive director. "By 1995, there were a total of 11 sites."

BASCOL provides beforeand after-school child care
throughout the school year, including school holidays, weeklong breaks, snow days, school
delays and half-days. It currently operates in the Liverpool, Onondaga Central, Solvay, West Genesee and
Westhill districts.

It also began providing summer care in 1997. The program is designed to meet each child's physical, social, emotional and intellectual needs, the organization's literature says. The core curriculum includes art, dramatic play, fine motor skills development, literacy, physical education, health and nutrition, science discovery, social and emotional development and special events including field trips.

after-school program. Our goals include being a fun and recreational-based program," Edwards said. "We create a safe, nurturing environment and our caring staff encourages each child to grow to their fullest potential."

In the beginning, BASCOL had a staff of two. That number has climbed to 42. In the classroom, the student to adult ratio is 10-1.

Edwards attributes 20-year success story to the people who make up the organization.

She called the staff "wonderful, caring and nurturing."

Katelyn Calkins, 10, from Liverpool said she likes spending her mornings and afternoons at the program. Her family has participated for six years.

"I would have never met my best friend if it wasn't for BASCOL," she said. Katelyn's mother, Karen

Katelyn's mother, Karen Calkins, of Clay, agrees, but for different reasons.

"As a working parent there is nothing more comforting than knowing your child is in good hands while you need to work," Calkins said.

"My children love the staff and the activities that are planned for them. Honestly, at times when picking up my kids, they have asked if I could come back later because they were having so much fun," Calkins said. "I am very grateful for the care they give my children."

Currently, there are 437 students enrolled.

Over the past 20 years, BASCOL has served more than 7,300 families.

However, the organization has experienced its ups and downs with enrollment.

"In the past 20 years, the demand for (the) child care has greatly increased year after year as more families began to need both parents working," said Edwards.

"However, during the past three years, with the changes in the economy, more families are looking to alternate care older siblings providing care, other family members, and older children staying by themselves," she said.

Looking to the future, Edwards said their goals are to expand into new areas in Upstate New York and to seek both state and national accreditation.

Within the next school year, BASCOL will apply for the state afterschool accreditation by Afterschool Works! New York, as well as The National Afterschool's accreditation for standards for quality school age care.
